WEATHER ADVISORY FOR NEXT WEEK (10th-16th July, 2017)
(Widespread rains predicted)

Pakistan Meteorological Department, Islamabad, has issued a weather advisory for the next week (i.e. from 10th-16th July, 2017), predicting widespread rains.

2. As per the Weather Advisory, widespread rain/thunderstorm with isolated heavy to very heavy falls are predicted in the country during the coming week (from 10th-16th July, 2017). PMD has informed that monsoon currents are expected to penetrate in upper parts of Pakistan from Sunday/Monday (9th/ 10th July, 2017) that will grip most parts of the country during the mid week. A Westerly Wave is also expected to grip upper parts of the country during the mid week.

3. Detailed forecast, as reported by PMD, Islamabad for next week is as under:

a. Punjab & Kashmir:

Rain/thunderstorm with isolated heavy to very heavy falls are expected at a number of places in Islamabad, Upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Lahore & Faisalabad Divisions) and Kashmir during Monday to Thursday (10th-13th July, 2017). Rain-thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls may occur over scattered places in Southern Punjab (D.G. Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur & Sahiwal Divisions) during Tuesday to Thursday (11th-13th July, 2017).

b. Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan & FATA:


Rain/thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls are expected at scattered places in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, FATA and Gilgit-Baltistan during the period from Tuesday to Thursday (11th-13th July, 2017).

c. Sindh & Balochistan:

Rain/thunderstorm with moderate to heavy falls are expected at scattered places in Sindh and Eastern Balochistan (Zhob, Sibbi, Naseerabad & Kalat Divisions) during Friday to Sunday (14th-16th July, 2017).

4. PMD has further informed that heavy to very heavy falls may generate urban flooding and flash flooding in the vulnerable areas, particularly in Local/ Barsati Nullahs of Punjab (Rawalpindi, Gujranwala & D.G. Khan Divisions), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Kashmir. Due to intermittent rains, there is risk of landslides in hilly areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Malakand & Hazara Divisions), Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir during the next week (10th-16th July, 2017).

5. All concerned authorities are advised to watch the situation closely and take all necessary precautionary measures in order to avoid loss of human lives and damage to private and public property.
